On behalf of our Board, staff, volunteers, and clients, thank you for your gift of \$50.00 to Colorado AIDS Project (CAP) in memory of Dan Manning. Your gift helps to further our mission of preventing HIV infection and improving lives affected by HIV and AIDS.

To prevent HIV infections, we are testing for HIV, as well as, educating and empowering at-risk individuals with information about HIV risks and transmissions. In 2010, more than 1,200 individuals were tested for HIV between HeyDenver and CAP and now know their status. We are on pace to exceed 1,500 free and confidential tests in 2011. That's 1,500 individuals who are now aware of their HIV status.

Annually, CAP supports 2,600 clients living with HIV and AIDS through support services such as case management, mental health and substance abuse counseling, housing assistance, transportation, food bank, employment center, and financial assistance. Each support service includes the ultimate goals of working with our clients to make healthy choices in order to increase their stability and access to healthcare for enhanced, healthier lives.
